Community:

Pikes Peak Christian School began elementary classes in 1986. With constant growth since then the school now encompasses classes from preschool through high school. The entire student population is 379. Pikes Peak Christian School draws students from all physical areas of Colorado Springs and diverse socio-economic backgrounds.

Admission requirements include confidential references, a review of a student's transcript, and an interview. Our mission is: *To provide a quality, Bible-based education taught by Christian teachers in a safe and compassionate environment. We strive to identify and develop the academic, social, and spiritual potential of each student in partnership with God and Family.*

School:

Pikes Peak Christian School is accredited through the National Christian Schools Association and Cognia. There are 55 students enrolled in the High School. The first graduating class was in 2003.

Curriculum:

8 classes a semester is the typical load for students. The schedule consists of 2 95-minute periods that meet every other day and 6 48-minute periods that meet every day. Pikes Peak Christian has 2 diploma programs, Advanced Honors and Regular. A minimum of 29 credits are required for graduation under the Advanced Honors Program and 27 credits for the Regular diploma program. ½ credit = 1 semester of work; 1 credit = 1 year of work.

Advanced Placement Courses (Weighted):

AP US History, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus BC, and AP English Literature are offered.

Honors Courses (Weighted):

Honors courses are offered in all core subject areas for freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors and are designated as honors (H).

Other Weighted Courses:

Physics and Anatomy & Physiology.

Grading and Class Rank:

Semester grades are recorded on the transcript. Class rank and cumulative grade point average are computed in January and May. Grade point average is computed on a 4.0 scale. Honors courses and AP are the exception and are weighted on a 5.0 scale.
