

2024 Creative Arts Scholarship Program

Guidelines

Pikes Peak Christian High School Creative Arts Department announces the 2024 Creative Arts Scholarship Program. Under this program there is one (1) \$500 scholarship that will be awarded to a member of the Pikes Peak Christian High School's senior class. All senior students who have been involved in Creative Arts (art, music, band, photography, graphics design, drama, STEM, etc.) are eligible to apply.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking graduating seniors with an interest and involvement in the Creative Arts Program during their high school career at PPCS.
- * Applicants must have a plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college or technical school.
- * Scholarship funds will be paid *in December 2024 or January 2025 for the second semester of the student's first year* directly to the college and not to the student. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to PPCS at that time an invoice for second semester tuition and fees, student ID number and college information.
- * Application should be <u>filled out in Google Docs</u> (including essay) and then submitted by email to <u>creativeartscommittee@ppcseagles.org</u> with a deadline of <u>Sunday, April 7th, by 11:59 p.m.</u> (Handwritten applications will not be accepted.)
- * Late applications will not be accepted.
- * Preference <u>may</u> be given to students pursuing a fine arts major, but this will only be a secondary factor. The primary determinant will be involvement in the arts while attending PPCS.

The applications will be reviewed and recipients selected by a committee consisting of Pikes Peak Christian Creative Arts Committee members. The scholarship will be awarded in May 2024 at the High School Awards Ceremony.
